Inspera SEB

We are starting to roll out the closed beta of Inspera SEB to a wider audience. Those that have already contacted us requesting to be an early beta tester will be prioritised.

The initial release of Inspera SEB includes:

- · Validating the integrity of the Safe Exam Browser module
- Embedded certificate pinning to prevent man-in-the-middle attack
- Dynamic blocking of blacklisted processes
- Continuous monitoring of local processes

We will provide more details on the roadmap for Inspera SEB in the near future.

Ended support for older SEB versions

We have now ended support for older SEB versions for Windows and Mac computers. The supported versions are 2.3 for Windows and 2.1.4 for Mac. See also our <u>system</u> requirements.

Deliver - Planner: keep thresholds when updating Question Sets

As mentioned in December 2019 Release Notes, we have introduced support for keeping the set threshold values on a test, if the updated or new question set contains the same number of maximum marks as the previous question set.

Changes in the Inspera API on the March release

- Iv1/users/student
 - New optional attribute on the user-object "password" for setting a strong password.

The password must be longer than 9 chars, contain both uppercase and lowercase characters and at least one number and one special character

- Note that the same attribute will be visible also for admin-users, but setting it here will have no effect.
- /v1/test/{testId}/assessment/{jobId}

- If async-job is not finished
 - before http-status 500 with progress-indicator
 - after http-status 200 with progress-indicator and a status-description

<u>/v1/test/{testId}/gradingScheme</u>

- If gradingScema does not exist:
 - before http-status 500
 - after http-status 204 No_content is returned

New features

We now support explanations in tests without student submission (grading only). When grading is finished and an explanation is sent to the candidate, this will be available for the candidate to read in their Archive.

Other improvements

Explanation of grades

Planner - <u>Administration of explanations</u> Confirmation is now required when enabling "Request explanations of all grades" in the test settings.

Postponed to the March release:

Monitor - Separate columns for whether explanation has been requested, and for status of explanation (Draft, Ready, Sent, Read).

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
