- April 9th: Adding support for version 3.1.1 for Windows

In the making New function in APIs to manage committees

The integration team is working on adding the handling and administration of committees in our open APIs. This function will include both creation and deletion of committees, adding graders and candidates to committees, and moving candidates and graders from one committee to another.

Expected release in April 2021.

In the making Two-way communication between students and invigilators

Inspira Chat will enable students to contact invigilators during remote exams.

More information will follow in the April release notes.

In the making Individual confirmations within test window

Soon graders will be able to confirm marks and grades for individual candidates before the test end time is reached.

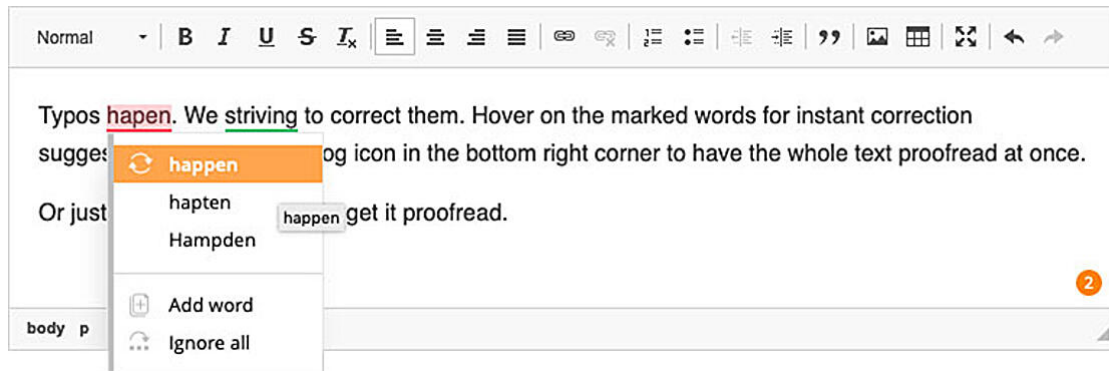

Essays: New spell checker available

It is now possible to enable the new and improved spell checker [WProofreader](#) for Essay questions.

- Regular dictionary updates ensure spell checks are always up-to-date

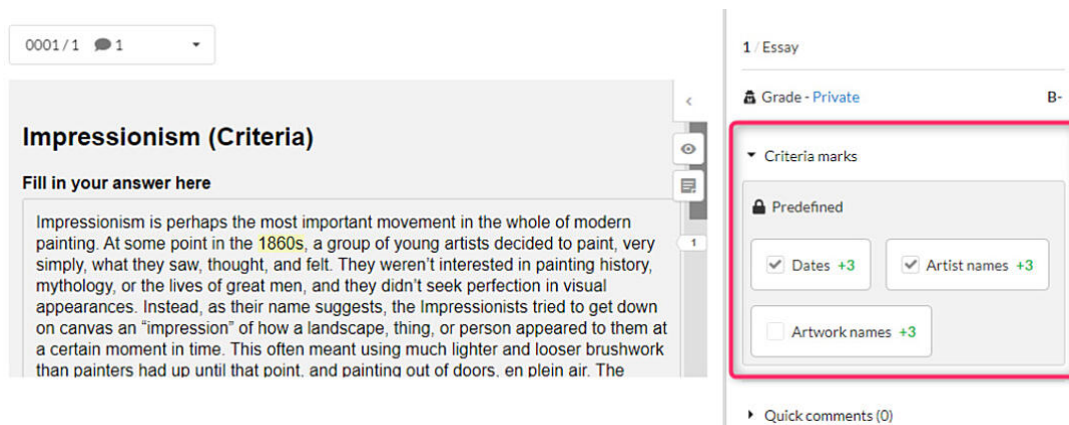

Marking 2.0

Criteria marking now supported

Questions with [Criteria marks](#) can now be marked in Marking 2.0, and selected criteria becomes available for candidates to view in the [Student Report](#).

Criteria marks in Set marks feature

Question weight now configurable per account

Question weight override in the Marking functionality is now controlled per account.

Please contact the Service Desk to have it enabled or disabled for your account.

Other improvements and bug fixes

- “Transfer to FS” button now hidden for Appeal committees
- Typing values directly in threshold editor in Marking 2.0 now supported
- Removed the extra progress bar on top of marking workspace that caused confusion to the user
- Better information about why graders can’t mark before the test is closed
- CSV upload of admins and permanent student users now permits creating users with email addresses that are already associated with existing users.
- Accessibility improvements in student test player:
 - Improved focus border on Cancel and Resume Test buttons
 - Improved information to candidates entering invalid input in Numeric Entry question type
 - Border colours darkened to increase contrast
 - Selection colours changed slightly to improve contrast
 - Improved identification of links that open in new tab or window
 - Focus border added to footer navigation to ensure focus is visible
- *Role* added to header and footer, so screen readers now can read “heading” and “navigation”
- Fixed issue with predefined feedback not being visible to candidates for Composite questions
- Fixed issue with responses to text and numeric entry in some cases not being displayed in PDF download

 - `/v1/candidates/pdf/{testId}/{userId}` for candidate submission
 - `/v1/test/{testId}/assessment/pdf` for download of test submissions

- API endpoint to download raw results score per evaluation round for all candidates on a test:
 - /v1/test/{testId}/allResults
 - Due to the large number of data in this call, we have made this as an asynchronous export. It follows the same rules for ordering of export as other API endpoints
- New API endpoints to download user data based on authType:
 - /v1/users/allAdmins/{authType} to schedule download of all admin users with specific authType
 - /v1/users/allStudents/{authType} to schedule download of all admin users with specific authType
 - Due to the large number of data in this call, we have made this as an asynchronous export. It follows the same rules for ordering of export as other API endpoints.

General API improvements

- OpenID connect as SSO in full release
- LTI integration to LMS improvements:
 - Names and roles provisioning and student unprovisioning in full release
 - Role based access to Inspera Assessment based on roles assigned in test in LMS
 - General improvements on LTI integration
- Improved allResults API to include both automatic marks and manual marks
