## Heads up

The new option in Monitor called *Grade verification (For Appeals)* will be made available during the next couple of weeks. The purpose of grade verification is to support administrative grade control, so that results can be made visible or kept hidden from the Inspira API.

## New features in Author

### Inline Gap Match

*Automatically marked. Included in all plans. Requires activation.*

[Inline Gap Match](#) allows authors to create text-based questions with a dynamically created token bank of correct answers. Correct answers can be either plain text, rich text, mathematical equations or images.

## Import and export Question Sets in QTI 2.1 format




### New features in Deliver

## Invigilator instructions

## Inspira API

### Update to Webhook notifications

Up until this release, webhook notifications required the receiving user to have a direct link to the context object on which the event occurred. Based on user feedback we are making it so that users that have extended access will receive a webhook notification for all objects, regardless of whether or not the user has a direct link to the object. Notifications will still only be sent on event types for which the user has explicitly subscribed.

### Submissions API now includes external deliveries

The submissions API now includes any external deliveries attached by an administrator. External deliveries are included under the 'ext\_inspira\_externalDelivery' field.

## Improvements

- Print Manager: Support for multiple questions pr page while keeping page breaks pr question

## Bug fixes

In this release we have spent some extra time exterminating bugs. Here are some of the more notable ones:

- Fixed an issue where the wrong time zone was used when displaying grading deadline and upload time in some cases.
- In rare cases stimulus documents that was added to a Question Set were not shown correctly in the authoring tool. This has now been fixed.
- When authoring questions with inline images, pasting text into the question could cause the image to be removed. This has now been fixed.
- Fixed an issue where keyboard navigation was not behaving as intended when using vertical sections.
- Fixed an issue where names containing characters outside of the latin alphabet were not shown correctly when used as sender name on notification emails.
- In some cases setting up an externally synchronized test using templates and non-anonymous candidates could lead to a mix of anonymous and non-anonymous candidates. This has now been fixed.
- About 40 other bugs got squashed in this release.

In addition to the user facing changes we announce in the release notes, we are always working on improving the technical components that make up Inpera Assessment. One of the areas we have been focusing on lately is decoupling even more parts of the system. This is enabling us to make bigger changes to the system without requiring full downtime. An example of this is the deployment of this release, where we paused student delivery and some indexing functionality while we completed required updates.
