
Print Manager / PDF submissions

Print styles for written responses

For good reasons, many graders and teachers prefer reading submissions by paper. When downloading submissions as PDF or printing individual submissions directly from the browser, users now have the option to apply *Print styles for written responses*.

How it works

When an optimised print style is selected, the font size and line spacing in Essays and Text Area *answers* is increased. The font is set to <u>Georgia</u>, a reading friendly serif typeface. Print styles are not applied to question texts.



Style options


- Standard: No print style applied.
- Optimised for reading: Provides a full width layout, serif typeface, increased font size and line spacing.
- Optimised for feedback: Provides a right column for marginal notes, serif type face, increased font size and line spacing.

Default print style for all users in account can be configured through Service Desk.

Authoring

Configurable left stimulus width

When editing section layout settings, authors now have the option to set default split ratio in vertical layouts.



The left column width is set as a percentage of full width


Highlights

- · Allow or deny students to change stimulus width during tests
- Default split can also be configured on account level, so that all new question sets share the same default vertical section split
- We have also improved the responsive rendering of the stimulus document

Test lists in Deliver and Grade

New column for number of candidates in test

The new column is available to Planners in Deliver and Grade. It allows sorting and filtering of tests by number of candidates *equal to / greater than / smaller than* or *between.*



To show column, open the column picker and select Number of candidates.

Other improvements
