Changes in SEB version support

In the June release note we reported that support for SEB 2.3 for Windows would end with the August release. Since then we have received requests to postpone this and SEB 2.3 for Windows will now be supported until release 4th September.

From 3rd July 2020

SEB 3.0 is now the default version for Windows.

- Audio recording question type is not supported in SEB 3.0
- Because SEB 3.0 does not support the mp4 video format, Inspera automatically converts videos added in this format. Please allow some time

when activating tests containing videos uploaded prior to this release.

Inspera Remote Exam

Inspera Remote Exam is now available to beta testers. We are aiming for a general release in August 7th. In June we made further improvements:

- Pre checks: Improved face detection for photo identification
- Usability improvement: Progress bar to show uploading of content and warning to not close it before uploading
- Feature: Added multi session support and support for SEB 3.0 for Windows
- Security: Many improvements and enhancements
- Resilience: Queuing of blocked processes in case of no internet connection

FS (Norway)

- Individual delivery deadlines are now continuing to sync after test start time

- Annotation channel All students now disabled by default

Marking 2.0

- Submission viewer: Added option to Print comments
- List of assigned graders now also available for tests with only one committee, and in tests with multiple graders, but not grouped in committees
- Fixed issue with submissions that had been signed off sometimes still visible in Marking 2.0
- Improved grouping of shortcuts in the Options menu

Login improvements

- Fixed issue with logging in with test codes: First and last name no longer case sensitive
- Improved UX when logging in with wrong account: When admin users now log in as student by mistake, and then try to open one of the admin tools, they will now see a more informative message about what has happened, and how to proceed.
