HEADS UP

The new comments tool is now enabled by default in new tests

The following changes took effect evening of 7th June 2019:

- The new comments tool enabled by default in all new tests created after 7th June
- Tests created before 7th June will not be changed and will use the commenting tool already selected in setup
- All existing test templates will be automatically updated to use the new tool. This means that all tests created from any template after 7th June will have new

commenting tool enabled by default.

- The old commenting tool will be available as a fallback option in all tests until 5th July.
- As a Planner, you can opt in or out of the new comments tool at any stage in the test life cycle.
- Comments in existing tests will not be removed and will still be visible to students in their dashboards if shared with them.
- Switching to the new tool in existing tests with status *Grading completed*, will unshare any comments created using the old tool.

New features

No activations required

Images as alternatives

As of today, you'll see a new *Images* option when editing alternatives in **Multiple Choice** and **Multiple Response** questions. Uploaded images are automatically resized to 150px.

Horizontal layout of alternatives

Multiple Choice and **Multiple Response** questions are also extended with an option to display alternatives horizontally. All option types (Text, LaTeX and Images) can be displayed this way.

A new Layout dropdown menu is now available below the Type selector.

Circular hotspots and multiple correct answers

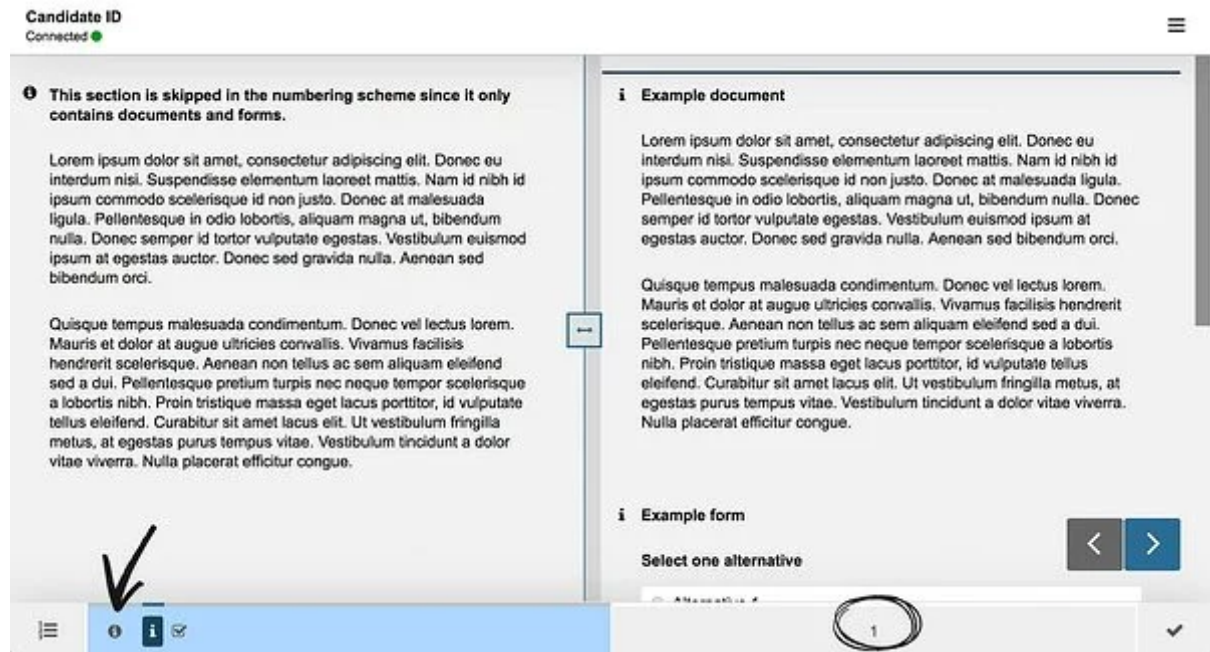
The **Hotspot** question type has been extended two ways:

- Circular hotspots enable authors to define clickable areas more precisely
- Multiple correct answers makes it possible to award marks in more than one hotspot, in a similar way as in the Multiple Response question type

Numbering schemes

Skipping sections only containing documents and/or forms

It is now possible to organise documents and forms in separate sections without breaking the automatic numbering of actual tasks.

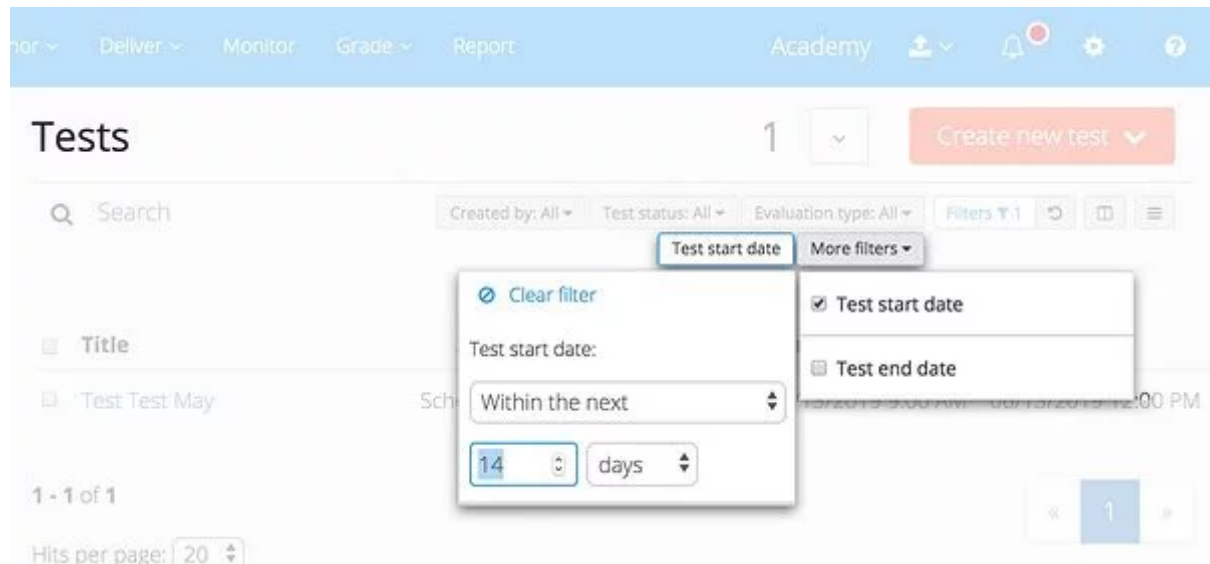


Sections without marked questions are labeled with an information icon. Section 1 above is the second section in the question set.

Deliver

Filter tests by start and end date

In the Deliver tool it is now possible to filter tests by start- and end date.



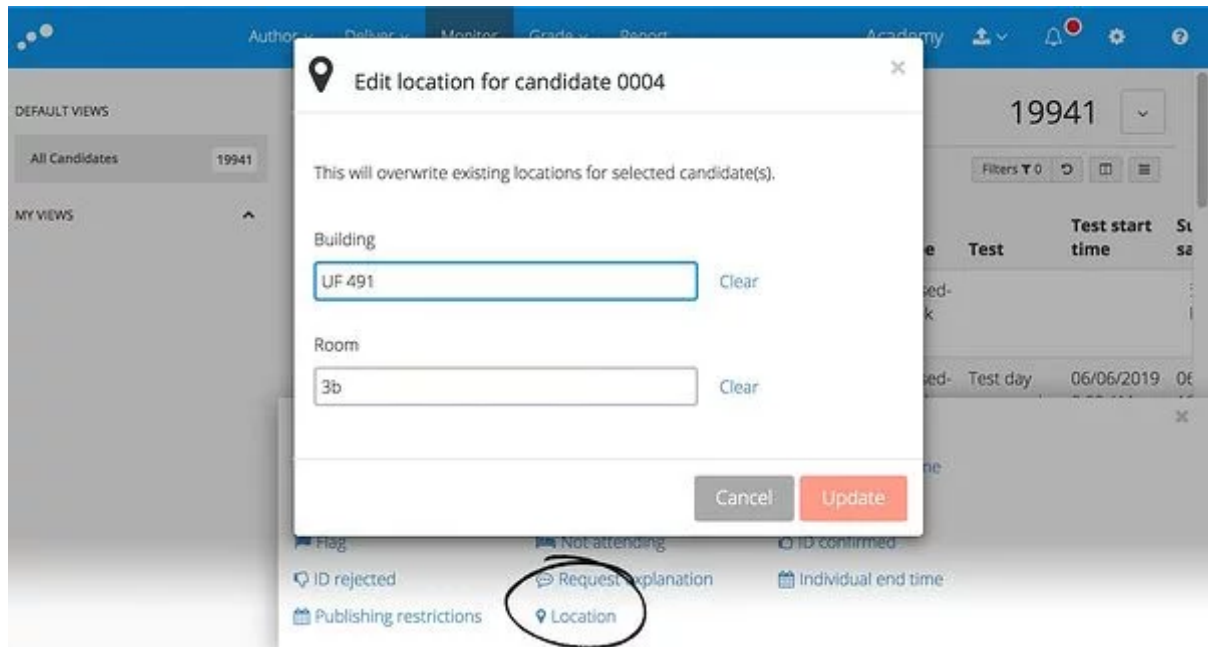
The new date filters are found under "More filters"

Monitor

Edit candidate locations directly in Monitor

Only available for candidates in tests not connected to external systems such as FS and Ladok.

It is now possible to edit candidate location properties (Buildings and Rooms) directly in Monitor.



The Monitor action is called Location and allows updating multiple candidates at once

CSV

New option to download total marks and final grade as CSV

It is now possible to download final grade and total score in a csv file containing the following fields:

- Candidate ID
- User ID
- Test title
- TestID
- External test ID
- Test start time
- Test end time
- **Final grade**
- **Total marks**

Planners downloading the csv will get Total marks from each grader as separate column. **Graders** will only get own total marks.

Annotation and comments

New comments tool

As mentioned above, the new comments tool is now out of beta and officially launched on all accounts. The new tool brings a better way to give feedback and collaborate with co-graders.

Analysér resultaterne vist på gelen i figur a:

The new commenting tool improves the user experience and speed for giving feedback, and brings new possibilities, such as:

- Post general comments on student answers (Page notes)
- Post comments to students or co-graders
- Reply to comments from co-graders
- Include mathematical notation in comments (LaTeX)
- Make draft comments (Post to *Only me*)
- Search comments and use [Markdown](#) for faster text formatting

The old comments tool is replaced in three steps:

- 10th May 2019 - Activation opens **COMPLETED**
- 7th June 2019 - Launch **COMPLETED**
- 5th July 2019 - Transition

Improvements released include:

- Fixed issue with annotation instructions wrongly showing for students
- Fixed issue requiring post-submission review enabled to share comments with students
- Fixed issue with *Student* category not always selected by default
- Language support in *Annotate* callout

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

- Improved information to students with unsupported version of SEB installed. To avoid confusion, success message about correct configuration file is now hidden.
- Fixed issue with students sometimes having status online after submitting SEB test
- Fixed issues with duplicating and publishing presets
- Improved responsiveness of audio and video player for students
- Log and notifications: Fixed issue with incident extra time sometimes showing as 0 minutes
- Fixed issue with Author mode in Deliver tool for users without permissions to the general Author tool
- Improved differentiation between internal and external FS grade transfer error messages
- Appeals: Fixed issue with results and explanations from primary round of grading hidden from primary round graders, when candidate is moved to an Appeals committee
- Fixed issue with Question Set preview sometimes visible to Chief Invigilators
- Improved responsiveness of navigation footer in Deliver so that all actions are always visible on small screens
- Fixed issue with using iPad for annotations in old comments tool
- Fixed issue with email to graders when no Feide username was set
- Fixed issue with filters in lists wrongly being reset when navigating back from tools and content
- Extended offline: Added warning about PDF panels not supported in offline packages
- Fixed issue with broken links to inline analytics documentation
