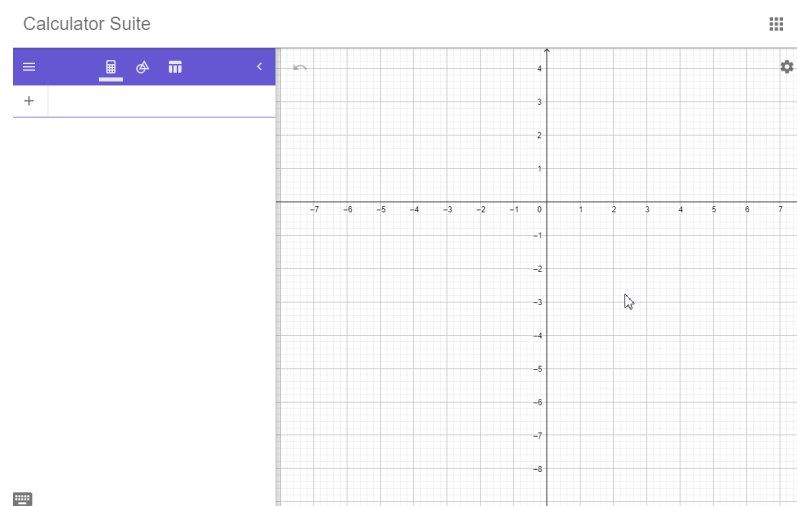

New in this release

These are the improvements and changes available from October 2nd 2020:

Ending support for GeoGebra question and stimulus type

As informed in previous release notes, we are fully ending support for GeoGebra as question type and stimulus type. Most aspects are no longer supported and by the end of next week support will be fully ceased. Marking 2.0: Threshold value editor is now available

As in the classic tool, the purpose of the Threshold value editor is to automatically determine the overall grade based on achieved marks.

The new version comes with a number of improvements, such as

- Resetting existing grades is no longer required to edit thresholds values
- Recalculation of grades is now a separate step. This allows experimenting with the threshold values and preview grade distribution live. The “Draft” threshold values are also visible to all graders, and allows collaboration.
- In tests with automatic questions only, grade calculation can be triggered directly using the new editor
- View list of all candidates that will have their grade recalculated before updating
- View list of all candidates that will not have their grade recalculated, due to manual grades, incomplete marks or confirmations.

Marking: Other improvements

- FS (Norwegian users): Vurderingskombinasjonskode (Variant) is now visible in both classic tool and Marking 2.0
- Annotations: In Deliver setup, a new option to control the availability of Co-grader channel
- Excel grade import: Improved information to users when import is completed.
- Fixed issue with navigation for bands and criteria questions.
- Fixed issue with committee selector sometimes showing incorrect number of candidates per committee
- New grade scale available: 0.0 - 10.0 with decimal steps (0.0, 0.1 ... > ... 9.9, 10.0) available

Added support for SEB 2.4.1 for Windows

We have received reports from customers experiencing issues with SEB 3.0.1 as this version does not close applications such as TeamViewer automatically. Based on requests we have added support for SEB 2.4.1 for Windows and also included links to download supported versions on our [system requirements](#) documentation in Help Center.

API improvements

For developers.

New API for controlling options on a test [/v1/test/{testId}/options](#)

The following settings are added in this release:

- Activate SEB settings on a test
 - Set SEB Pincode
 - Set invigilator password
- Activate Chromebook kiosk setting

- Set Invigilator password
- Activate explanation of grades
 - Enable administration of explanations
 - Request explanation of all grades
 - Allow grades to send explanation of grades directly to candidates
 - Set deadline for explanation

New options will be added to the new API in future releases and will be announced through release notes.

FS Integration improvement

- Non - anonymous tests: Updated GET method for [/v1/test/{testId}/appeals](#) to return student FS ID in separate field

URKUND integration improvements

- Submission under 430 characters will trigger exception displayed in Inspira Assessment stating that submission is too short for plagiarism control

Updated GET method for [/v1/test/{testId}](#) and [/v1/test/{testId}/submissions](#) API with field for question pulling

- Field *MaxScoreAfterSelection* was added to test APIs for export of maximum achievable score on a test where pulling of questions is activated.

Important information

Delay in Turnitin integration

Due to a new requirement that has to be included to ensure the basic Turnitin integrations works as intended, there will be a slight delay in Turnitin basic integration (by one release). New planned release dates are:

- Beta version (for testing) - November release
- Full release - December release

Clarification on Urkund 1.1 release

For customers that have Urkund integration activated.

In the September release we announced new features in Urkund integration, including individual send addresses for submissions. This feature requires

activation. Please contact your Inspira primary contact or our Service Desk to activate functionality in Inspira.

Improvement to test taker banner

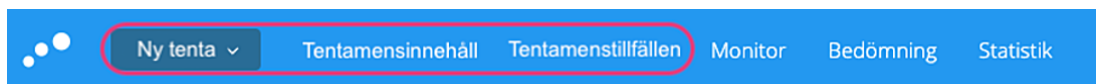
In November release we will introduce a configurable *Connection lost messages* per test or template and improve the layout of the header in the student interface.

Update of Swedish expressions

For our Swedish language users only.

After feedback and wishes from customers, we will in the November release update some Swedish expressions in Inspira. No new functionality comes with this, everything will work as usual. Only a couple of words will be different in the interface:



“Tenta” instead of “Prov”, as well as “Tentamensinnehåll” and “Tentamenstillfällen” instead of “Uppgifter” and “Prov” in the header for Swedish HE.



“Provinnehåll” and “Provtillfällen” instead of “Uppgifter” and “Prov” in the header for Swedish k12.

Item banking (testing only)

Ability to sort and store questions and content in a folder-like structure with structure and sorting features. There is also access restrictions and rules setting per item bank. This will first only be available for testing upon request.

VDI support (testing only)

Possibility to utilise Virtual Desktop Infrastructure (VDI).

This will first only be available for testing upon request.

Improvements to Marking 2.0

- Assign questions to graders
- Navigation in randomized/pulling section
- View log events
- Record audio feedback

Basic Turnitin integration

Ability to send candidate responses for plagiarism control via Turnitin. This will first only be available for testing upon request.

API and integration improvements coming next months

- New API to create, update and delete organizational units
 - Beta version - November release
 - Full feature release - December release
- Urkund integration improvement
 - Display Inspira events when Urkund integration returns error for better user experience - November release
- Options API - new feature planned releases:
 - Exam day settings - November release
 - Security settings in addition to SEB / Chromebook - November release
 - General settings - November / December release
 - Setting grading scale on test - December release
 - After test settings - December release
 - Grading workflow - January 2021 release
- FEIDE login changes (Norwegian high-ed)
 - Change FEIDE login to store students FEIDE ID - December / January release
- New API endpoint for export of test events - January release
 - The following events will be included in the export:
 - Absence
 - Incident extra time
 - Warnings including time and information
 - Manual log events
 - Pausing events
